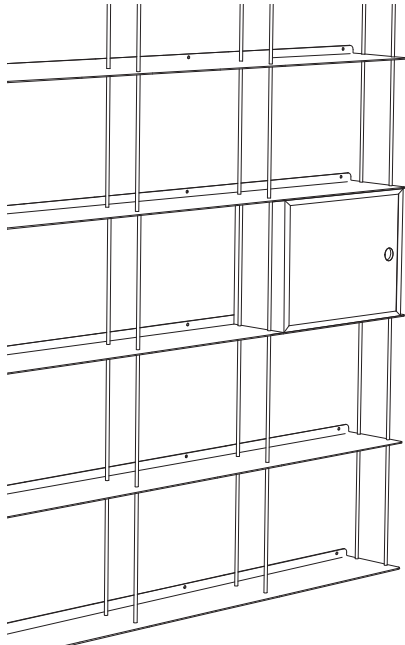


# KROSSING WALL SYSTEM








Once it is full of books, a Krossing structure tends to camouflage and makes room to the items. This is an ideal structure for novel books; in the kitchen, to store glasses, cups, jars and spices; in the bathroom to store creams or in the kids bedroom, to display toys. This system allows to create either squared shaped structures or more fun and creative compositions.

## WORKING PRINCIPLE

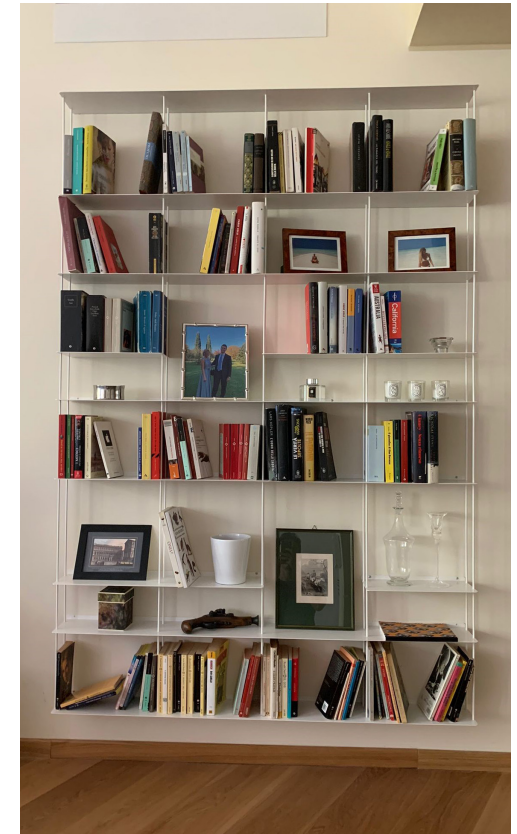
Simple grid system composed of shelves, tubes and wood boxes. It has been designed to hold a high number of books and small items with a particularly low footprint of 15 cm.



## FINISHES

-  Anodised Aluminium
-  Matte white RAL 9010
-  Matte black RAL 9005
-  Oak wood
-  Walnut wood
-  Matte white lacquered RAL 9010
-  Matte black lacquered RAL 9005

On request, components can be custom-made or coated with a special RAL colour.

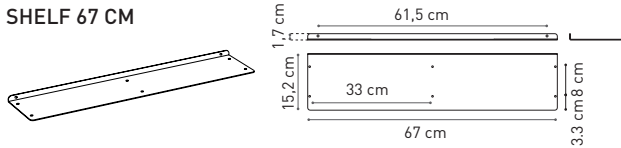


**MILLED SHELF 34 CM (GLASSES HOLDER)**

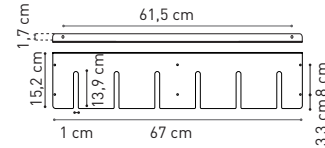
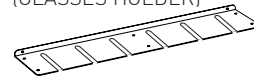

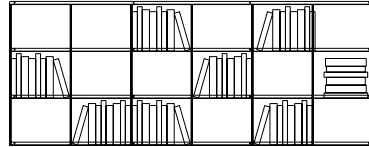
## BOOKSHELVES | REGULAR

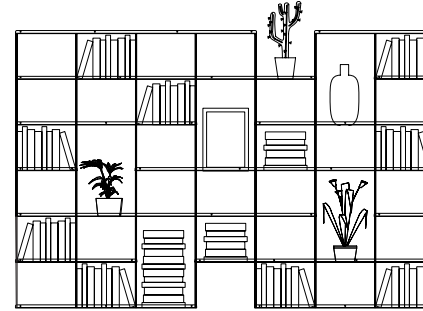
## BOOKSHELVES | STRIPE SHAPE

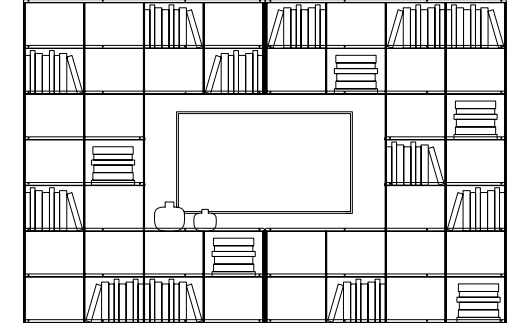

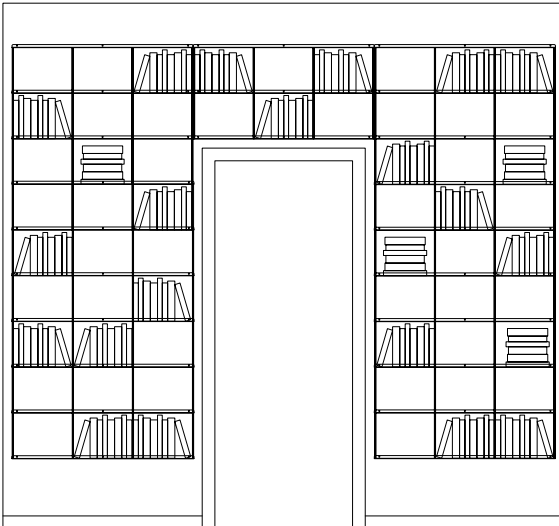

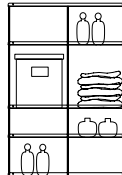

# KROSSING CLEANING AND CARE TIPS

## METAL COMPONENTS



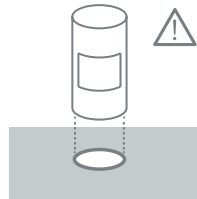
For regular cleaning, use a dish detergent and a wet cloth.



Do not use products that contain acetone, vinegar or ammonia.



Do not use abrasive sponges or cleaning creams that can scratch the surfaces.



Chemical products such as room fragrances can create stains that can permanently damage the surfaces.

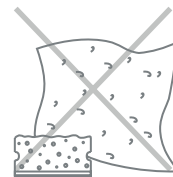
## ELEMENTI IN LEGNO



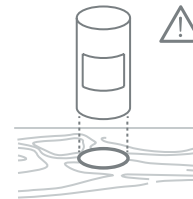
For a regular cleaning use a smooth cloth (wet or dry).



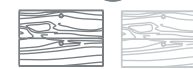
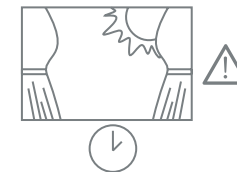
Do not use products that contain acetone, vinegar or ammonia.



Do not use buffers or microfiber clothes that can scratch the surfaces.



Fat stains of vegetal or animal origin and acid liquids such as sodas can permanently damage the surfaces.



Wood is a living material that has natural color and grain variations. Lights and sun rays create color variations over the time.



Surfaces are sealed with a high quality coat. We recommend to not expose the wood components to a too dry or too wet air. Otherwise, and in spite of the coating, the wood pieces could deform.
